

Reasons for Sanctions – Further Information

Reason Given for Sanction	Further Information
Poor behaviour in lessons	The student has not met behaviour expectations in lessons.
Yellow card	The student has disturbed the learning of others and has had to be removed from the classroom to work with another member of staff in a sixth form lesson or similar.
Homework	The student has not completed homework to either the deadline set or to an acceptable standard.
Mobile Misuse	The student's mobile phone has been used, seen or heard during the school day. To read the mobile phone usage policy, please refer to the school website.
Lates	The student has been late more than three times in a half term period.
Uniform	The student has failed to comply with uniform rules. This may include shirt untucked, blazer sleeves rolled up or similar. Students are aware of uniform expectations and are regularly reminded of them.
Equipment	The student has failed to have essential equipment at least three times in a half term period. Lists of equipment that students are expected to have are displayed in tutor rooms and classrooms and were published to parents at the start of the school year.
Defiance	The student has refused or chosen not to follow an instruction given by a member of staff or sixth form supervisor.
Insolence	The student has been rude to, or made fun of, a member of staff or sixth form supervisor.
Bullying	The student has indulged in bullying behaviour such as name-calling, pushing, posting unpleasant comments online or similar.
Poor report	A student who is 'on report' has not met clearly defined expectations.
Out of bounds	The student has been in an area of the school that they are forbidden to access. Out of bounds areas are clearly communicated to students at the start of each year and by supervisors and duty staff as appropriate.
Inadequate work	The student has not put enough effort into completing their work, either leaving it unfinished or of a poor standard.
