FAQ:

Q How will we get there?

A Coach to UK airport then flight to Berlin. Coach transfer in Berlin

Q How will we travel around Berlin?

A On foot and by public transport.

Q Is there a lot of walking then?

A Yes, quite a lot.

Q What will we eat?

A Breakfast will be a self service buffet: bread, rolls, jam, cereals, fruit, yoghurt, ham, cheese.

For lunch you will make your own sandwiches at breakfast time and you will be given a bag to put it in with a drink and a piece of fruit. Evening meals are at the hotel and will be delicious and nutritious. Vegetarian options will be available if notified in advance of the visit.

Q Who will I room with?

A That's your choice – start organising it now. Usually students are roomed 6 to a room.

Q How much spending money will I need?

A Not much. All meals in Berlin are included. You will have the opportunity to buy souvenirs and you might like to buy a drink when we are bowling. If as hoped our airport is Bristol, we will not be stopping at service stations.

Q I don't do History. Is this visit for me?

A Yes. This isn't a History visit as such although we will look at some of the history of Berlin. If you are interested in, or are studying, Languages, Art, Philosophy, Architecture, Culture and Geography this visit is for you.
