

Year 11 PPEs - Mon 9th Dec to Fri 20th Dec 2019

All Year 11 students have exams between Monday 9th Dec and Friday 20th Dec. Exams will take place in the Sports Hall, with the exception of Art (Art block) and Music (Sixth Form Study Area). Students will be informed separately if they have alternative arrangements for the exams. **Where there are exam clashes, an alternative time has been arranged and you will be given a personal timetable in due course.**

If students miss an exam due to absence, they will be expected to complete the exam at the first available opportunity on their return. They should report to the Exam Office to discuss the timing and location of the exam. Friday 20th Dec has also been allocated to complete any remaining catch-up exams – after this, students will be expected to complete the exams on their return in January.

Notes for Students

- Between Mon 9th and Wed 11th Dec, you must register with your tutor as normal and if you do not have an exam you should go to your usual timetabled lesson.
- From Thu 12th Dec, you must sign in when you arrive in school before you go to the exam room, and when you have no exam you either report to the study room, or you may go home to study.
- You must sign in and out every day so we know who is on site.
- You are not allowed anywhere on the school site during lesson times where you are unsupervised – you should be in an exam or in the study room.
- You must report to the exam room 10 minutes before the published start time.
- Early lunch will be available for students sitting exams in the afternoon, where needed.
- There will be a seating plan displayed outside the Sports Hall – check it before you enter for each exam.
- If you are entitled to extra time or other alternative arrangements for your exams, you will be informed in advance. You will receive further details of your arrangements nearer the exams.

Examination Rules for Students

- No bags are allowed in the exam room (leave them in your locker).
- You must not talk to anyone except a member of staff once you have entered the exam room.
- You must hand in any mobile device at the start of the exam (including iPods, MP3/4, mobile phones and smartwatches).
- Wrist watches need to be taken off and placed face down on the desk.
- All exams require you to write in black ink only, with diagrams drawn in pencil.
- You must be fully equipped for all your exams and you must only use a see-through pencil case.
- Do not use correcting pens, fluid or tape, erasable pens, highlighters or gel pens in any answers.
- You may take water into the exam room in a clear container, but you must remove the label.
- You cannot take any notes into the exam room.
- You may use a calculator if the examination paper allows it, but you must re-set it at the start of the exam.

Revision

Students are expected to revise thoroughly for all their examinations, and there are numerous sources of support available. Information regarding examination preparation is available on the school website. Students can also access online support for their revision in many subject areas, and teachers will advise students on suggested websites they might find useful.

Queries
