If your child is not marked present and, if no call has been received at the House Office by 9am, they will telephone to verify the child's whereabouts. This is a requirement by the DfE and also a Safeguarding process.</p> <p>Pershore High School's Family Support Officer, Caroline Bassett, may visit your home to discuss any concerns or issues that might be impacting your child's attendance and punctuality.</p> <p><b>Safeguarding note:</b> If a child is absent from school and we are unable to contact a parent or carer, we reserve the right to complete a 'safe and well' check by visiting the family home to ensure that the child is safe. If this check is not successful in confirming the child's whereabouts, we might then contact 101 and request that the police do a 'safe and well' check.</p>
FORM TUTORS	<p>Each Form has an email address – the Tutor Group initials and then @pershore.worcs.sch.uk</p>	<p>Form Tutors see your child for up to 30 minutes a day, split between morning Registration and afternoon Tutor Time. Form Tutors support students on a daily basis and are able to liaise with parents regarding minor pastoral and academic issues.</p>
